**PLEASE PRAY!** If we want our Campaign to be successful, our best asset is **PRAYER**. We have **7 weeks** to raise **£1.5m** to and buy back the former Priory and St Mary's School next door (total Net Internal Area of



1,383.19 Sq m or 14,891 Sq ft.) **plus an extra £280k for estimated conversion of offices to pastoral use.**

This is a unique opportunity to endow St Mary's with the space we urgently need: parish hall, music room, clergy offices, and classrooms. In addition, a pro-life office, a publishing company, a catholic bookshop, a vestments-sewing workshop and accommodation for retreatants could be added.
